Results of this survey thought to be of importance to the respondents:

- a) Booking on the day for appointments was most important overall
- b) Of equal value to the participants, booking appointments in advance, seeing their usual doctor and that a variety of services was available at the surgery.

Results of this survey

a) Participants felt that changes should be made with the way information is made available about our appointments and why patients are not always seeing the doctor they are registered with.

Outcome

a) The practice will look into the ways in which information is shared with it's population, following suggestions from members of the patient group.
